



Construction of upgrades and improvements to Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission (PVSC) Contract No. B359 (NJWB Project No. S340698-61) - Plantwide Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) System Improvements Program – Wet Train/Line Operations Project, located in Newark, NJ, 07105, in the amount of \$6,570,261.00, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by increasing reliability of process monitoring and operations throughout the Wet Train and Line Operations via updating the PVSC SCADA system components. The improvements will benefit residents and businesses in PVSC's service district within Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Passaic and Union Counties.
