

Construction of upgrades and improvements to an Emergency Repair on Kingsland Ave. between Hamilton Street and Harrison Avenue, located on the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission, Branch Interceptor within the Town of Harrison, Hudson County, New Jersey were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The project has an estimated cost of \$9,500,000. The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by making repairs to a section of the branch sewer that has been experiencing settling which has reduced conveyance capacity.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
