Join Us: Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission (PVSC) Standby Power Generation Facility Public Workshops

Background

Superstorm Sandy caused historic high coastal flooding and rainfall that affected numerous wastewater treatment plants and electrical service throughout New Jersey, which in turn caused disruptions to the treatment of sewage. PVSC's treatment plant was affected and critical parts flooded, causing uncontrollable discharges of waste.

In order to prevent this from occurring again and to ensure the continued treatment of sewage in its 48-municipality treatment district, PVSC is working to make its plant more resilient to coastal flooding, high rainfall, and power interruptions.
