The State Archives maintains naturalization records for the following counties and time periods:

Burlington – 1795-1956

Ocean – 1857-1951

Camden – 1844-1932

Sussex – 1817-1952

Essex – 1792-1931

Union – 1857-1906 (to 1931 on film).

Mercer – 1838-1930 (Declarations to 1940)

To initiate a search of up to five years, send this completed form and payment to the address above. Make checks payable to: *New Jersey General Treasury*. This fee includes copies up to five (5) pages. Additional pages will be billed at \$1.00 per page. Searches are done in the order in which they are received. **Required fields are in bold text.**

For other counties, contact the appropriate County Clerk. Note: Naturalization records also fell under the jurisdiction of the Federal District Courts after 1906.
