I am receipt of the Cape May Point Wastewater Management Plan prepared by the Borough dated February 15, 2010.


The DRAFT plan has been reviewed by my staff and is acceptable to the Department as Cape May Point's chapter of the Cape May County Wastewater Management Plan for purposes of completing the requirements for Plan Endorsement and to become a CAFRA Village Center.

The DRAFT Cape May Point Wastewater Management Plan establishes a revised wastewater service area boundary that serves the Borough while excluding sensitive environmental resources such as beaches, dunes and wetlands. The plan also ensures that the Borough has an adequate water supply, as well as adequate wastewater treatment capacity at the Cape May Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility.

Please be advised that Cape May County will require the Borough to review, prepare and submit additional information regarding wastewater management as part of the County's comprehensive wastewater management planning process. As you know, the County has accepted the responsibility of preparing a new Wastewater Management Plan, but has not yet begun working with County municipalities. This DRAFT Cape May Point Wastewater Management Plan will serve as the basis for completing the wastewater management planning process and inclusion in the new Cape May County Wastewater management Plan.
