

**Water conservation Measures**  
**City of Ocean City**

The City of Ocean City's efforts in the area of water conservation include actions which limit water use by the City for landscaping and public buildings.

All new irrigation systems that have been purchased include rain sensors that regulate the irrigation schedules related to rainfall thus saving water. In addition, drip irrigation has been used on several recent projects on garden plots and in flower beds and is being incorporated in the new landscape portion of the bridge project.

Indigenous plants have been incorporated into many of the projects including 58<sup>th</sup> Street Pavillion, 59<sup>th</sup> Street Restrooms and several street end improvement projects. Species include rugosa rose, bayberry, and grasses.
