Incentive Programs

Local Government Energy Audit

If You Are:

A municipal or local government official with publicly-owned facilities, such as offices, courtrooms, town halls, police and fire stations, sanitation buildings, transportation structures, schools and community centers and your facilities are located within the service territory of at least one of New Jersey's public utilities, you are eligible to participate.

You Can Apply For:

A subsidized investment grade energy audit.

In The Amount Of:

The program subsidizes 75% of the audit cost.

- If the net cost of the installed measures recommended by the audit, after applying eligible New Jersey SmartStart Buildings® incentives, exceeds the remaining cost of the audit, then the remaining 25% of the audit cost will also be paid.

To Be Used For:

Identifying cost-justified energy efficiency measures.

Benefits:

When the audit is complete, you will have a list of recommended, cost-effective energy efficiency measures and facility upgrades that will reduce operating expenses and, in many cases, improve the health and productivity of the buildings' occupants. Those measures are eligible for additional incentives available through the New Jersey SmartStart Buildings Program.

Program Details:

- The Local Government Energy Audit is part of New Jersey's Clean Energy Program™ administered by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.
- Participating municipalities select from a list of pre-qualified auditing firms who follow the strict parameters of the program and deliver an investment grade audit.
- To ensure the opportunity for participation by many local governments throughout the state, this program is subject to a \$100,000 annual incentive cap for each participant.
