New Jersey Manufacturing Extension Program (NJMEP)

If You Are:

A small to mid-sized manufacturing company in New Jersey.

You Can Apply For:

Technical and business training and consulting services are available through the New Jersey Manufacturing Extension Program (NJMEP) to any New Jersey manufacturing company that is interested in improving operations.

To Be Used For:

Implementing lean practices, initiating business growth strategies, business continuity planning, securing research and development or energy tax credits, introducing green manufacturing or other business improvement processes, as well as workforce training.

Benefits:

- NJMEP field agents and instructors are experts in meeting the needs of manufacturers.
- The organization is a federally funded nonprofit, and a NIST MEP network affiliate.
- Fees for services are below market rates.
- NJMEP secures New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development Customized Training Grants to help manufacturers implement programs that otherwise would not be possible.

Program Details:

- Field agents meet with manufacturers to discuss areas that are hindering companies' development and identify opportunities to help companies grow.
- A plan of action is designed for implementing a program for the identified area(s).
- When appropriate, funding sources are identified to reduce the financial pain of implementing programs.
- NJMEP assists clients with the application process and when approved, assists in all required reporting.
- Programs are implemented using a network of New Jersey-based specialists from universities, county colleges and the private sector.
- Ongoing improvement programs are available to help companies maintain and grow the success achieved through the initial program(s).
