TEACH provides a way to engage the entire school community on the topic of energy efficiency and provides energy use and cost benchmarking for each school in the district.

Program Details:

- Teaching Energy Awareness with Children's Help (TEACH) is part of New Jersey's Clean Energy Program administered by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.
- The building evaluation component allows schools ranked in the top 25% to receive an ENERGY STAR award from the US Environmental Protection Agency.
