 that I the said Samuel Guthrie for the love & affection that I doe bear to David
 Bilant in Amboy in the said probins gentleman and for considerable summs of money
 advanced by the said David equivalent to the summs of five hundred pound
 money have given granted confirmed and by this my present writing doe fully
 freely & absolutely give grant & confirm unto the said David Bilant his heirs
 executors or assigns all & singular my goods chattels personall estate and
 velle whatsoever together with all dispositions bonds back bonds & heretages
 and other titles & forwities for land which I have or can claime any right unto
 lying in the hands of James Donaldson, James Somerville or any other person
 whatsoever within the Kingdom of Scotland and particularly the right of my
 house & land in the land market in the south side of the street in the City of
 Edinburgh in Scotland do have hold have use & dispose of, take & enjoy all my
 goods, Chattels, leases personall & velle of lands velle & advantages of velle due
 unto me & receivable by my factor or which might have been receivable of out of
 my lands houses & tenement whatsoever belonging or which may belong to me by
 law, unto the said David Bilant his heirs executors administrators or
 assigns from henceforth & for ever, without any manner of claims challenges
 or demand whatsoever providing always that the same shall be
 paid upon the payment of two hundred pound sterling lawfull money of
 England to me hand paid & delivered before the making & granting this
 presents & sealing & delivery of the same. And I the said Samuel Guthrie
 doe bind & oblige me my heirs executors & assigns in England or
 Scotland or else where, to pay the said sum of two hundred pounds
 lawfull money of England to the said David Bilant his heirs executors
 or assigns or full perfect powerable possession & delivery & possession of all
 rights of lands bonds & other aboves mentioned lying in the hands of the
 persons aboves named or any others until perfect & true payment be made
 And will warrant this presents against all people In witness whereof
 I have signed sealed & delivered these presents to the said David at
 Wood Bridge in the said probins the last day of December one thousand
 six hundred Eighty five of the reign of King James the sixth of
 England, Scotland, France & Ireland the first year - Samuel Guthrie
 In presence of David Gowrie Esq: Alexander Wood Bridge the last day
 of December 1685 personally appeared before me Samuel Guthrie and
 acknowledged the within written deed to the said David Bilant within designed
 to be his act & deed - Sam^l Hales Justice. 20

In the name of God Amen I Samuel Guthrie presently in
 Wood Bridge in the probins of East new Jersey Gentleman being in good sound
 and perfect memory & praise be to the Lord God) although
 I be weak in body through sickness doe make & ordaine this my present
 last will & testament In maner & forme following First I recommend my soule
 into the hands of Almighty God, hoping to be saved through the merits of Christ, and
 I commit my body to the earth to be decently & Christianly buried at the discretion
 of David Bilant my executor after mentioned, and as touching all my tem-
 porall estate as it hath by the blessing of Almighty God to beflow upon me I give
 dispose thereof as followeth First I will that my debt contracted or that
 shall be contracted in the time of my sickness in Richard paulls house in
 Wood Bridge conform to and amount under the said Richard his hand be satisfied
 & payed, and that all the funeral charges which shall be bestowed in decently
 & orderly burying of my body by the said Richard or any other shall likewise
 be payed out of the first & readiest of my estate by my executor David Bilant
 in Amboy in the said probins of East new Jersey gentleman to whom I
 give & bequeath all my personall estate & make him my full sole executor
 of this my last will & testament. And I desire that my body may be buried in the
 ordinary buriall place at Wood Bridge, and I doe hereby revoke & annulle & make
 void all former wills & testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof

I the said Samuel Gutwin to this my last will & testament doe sett my
 hand & seals the thirteenth day of November in the year 1652 & of
 the reign of our Sovereign Lord King James the first of England
 the fourth of Scotland the first year - Samuel Gutwin signed sealed
 & delivered in presence of George Adams the mark of John Walkers &

 the said proprietors of the province of New Jersey for greeting know you that the said

 having under his hand & seal the goods & chattels to be administered within the said province & the right of

 said goods & chattels to the said George Adams & the said John Walkers & the said gentlemen of the
 said will & testament amended named & to be administered to the said province & county in or before the
