Gloucester County April 16<sup>th</sup> 1761

In Pursuance of the order to me Directed bearing Date the Thirteenth Day of August (1700) Requiring me to Survey for Richard Somers the quantity of Three thousand acres of Land in the Western Division of New Jersey and by vertue of a former one from Richard Somers unto Xaverius & Inatius Woods for Two hundred acres of the same by Deed Dated the Fifth Day of April (1701) I have Surveyed for the said Xaverius & Inatius Woods the following Described Land in part thereof in said Division on the North side of a branch of Little Egg Harbour River that puts out of Crips Cedar swamp BEGINNING at a pine tree marked four Blyes and twelve Notches and the Letters S W standing North by West from Shains Castle Thence D South twenty Chains to a post standing in a Line of William Hootons Cedar swamp Thence D South Sixty three Degrees East forty one Chain & fifty Links by Hootons line and by a line formerly run for Thomas David & Elizabeth Clark to a post Thence D North thirty Nine Chain to a post Thence D West thirty six chains and fifty links to the tree first named Containing One hundred acres and the usual allowance for roads Chainbearers were Sebastian Woose and
