In pursuance of orders to me Directed bearing date the tenth day of May one thousand seven hundred and twenty one I have been directed by the Devises of Abraham Porter or his Assigns the Quantity of two hundred and fifty acres of land appropriated to him below the falls of Delaware River at Frankford by Virtue of a Conveyance from John Stone Deviser of the said Abraham Porter) unto John West of the same two hundred and fifty acres By Deed dated the twenty first Day of September 1772 I have surveyed for the said John West part thereof situate in the County of Gloucester in the Western Division of New Jersey a parcel of Land between Reseaching whereon John West's Saw Mill is erected) and Macheco two Branches of Little Egg Harbor River and is bounded as follows Beginning at a pine tree EW starting by the North side the N. V. Chesapeake Creek a Little below the Sawmill and about Six perches below a small gully and from thence Running N North twenty seven Degrees East forty two Chains to a pine tree T. G. Corner to a cedar tree surveyed to Thomas and David Clark standing by the South side the Goose ponds then along the South side thereof N North fifty nine Degrees thirty Minutes West fifty nine Chains seventy Links to a pine and over Don's mill site up to the edge S South fifty eight Degrees West twenty three to a pine tree EW then N North thirty four Degrees and thirty Minutes West fifteen Chains to a pine tree E. 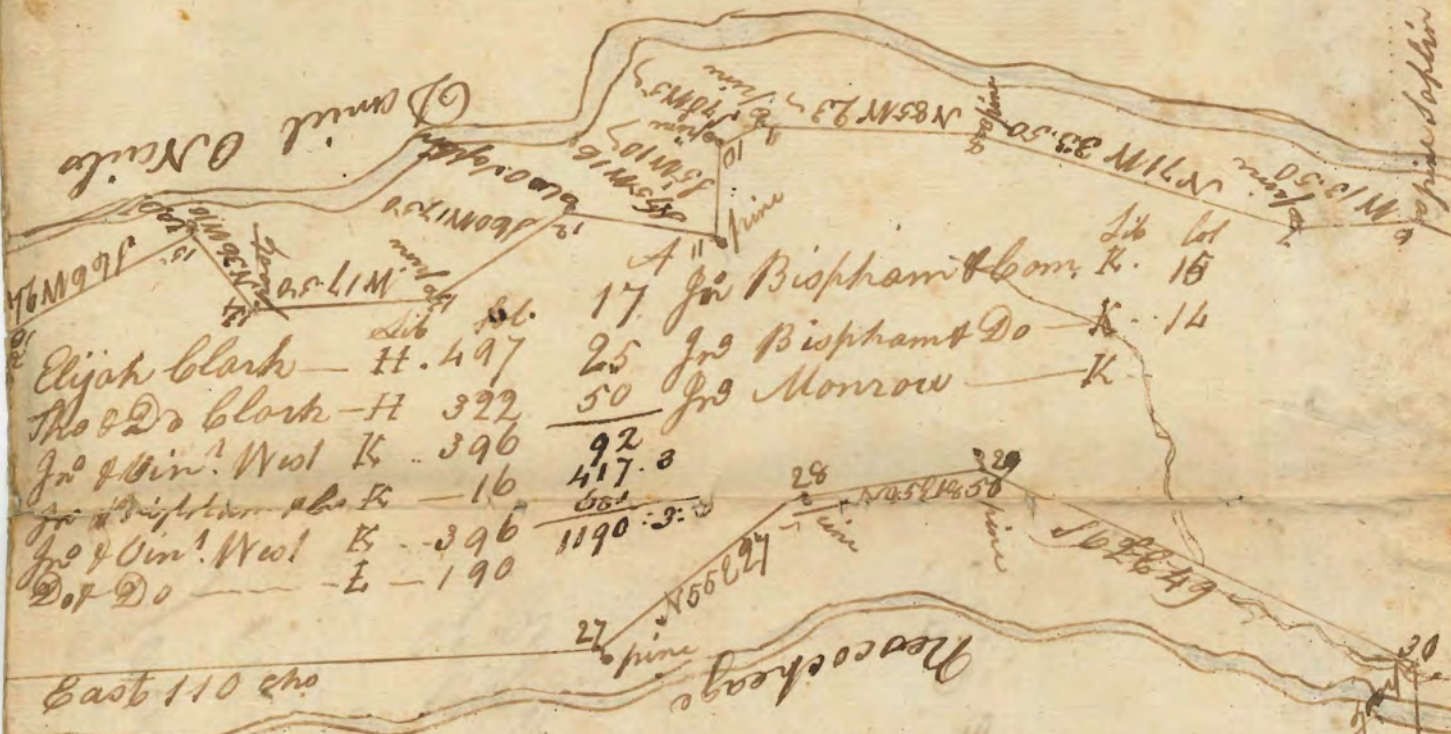

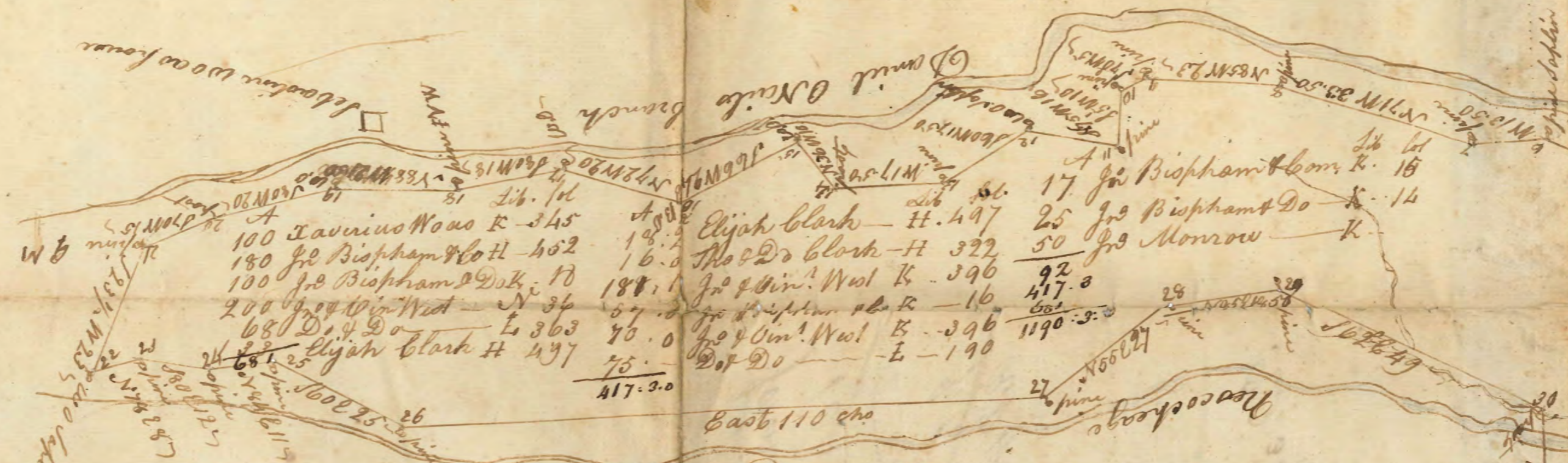
