Boundary in manner following viz Beginning at a capline oake Standing by y<sup>e</sup> head of mill run in y<sup>e</sup> Woodway Road to Gloucester thence down the Several Courses of st<sup>r</sup> run unto y<sup>e</sup> mouth thereof at Place off Beginning it self into the Southly branch off Norton Creek So up y<sup>e</sup> Several Course of st<sup>r</sup> branch unto y<sup>e</sup> mouth off another Run being y<sup>e</sup> bounds off John Mickles Land So up y<sup>e</sup> Several Course off y<sup>e</sup> st<sup>r</sup> run unto an oake for a corner Standing neare a fork off the st<sup>r</sup> run from thence South Easterly fifty dgs Sixty and a half to another corner thence South Westerly fifteen dgs thirtoon chains by Mathew Woodall Land to a Post or Stake Standing in y<sup>e</sup> afore<sup>d</sup> high road and So from thence unto y<sup>e</sup> first mentioned Corner

By virtue of an order from Andrew Roberson Surveyor General I did Survey unto Francis Collins in Right of his bound & severalty &c: of a Propriety of Land in the Town the Severnleenth day off y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> second month annoque Domini 1690 Boundary in manner following viz Beginning at a corner Standing by y<sup>e</sup> Southly branch off Norton Creek thence by some Land off Andrew Roberson now Abraham Albersons South Westerly Seventeen dgs forty three chains & a half to a corner thence by y<sup>e</sup> high Road to Gloucester North Westerly fifty dgs thirty nine Chains & a half to a corner Standing by y<sup>e</sup> head off a small Run & So down the same to y<sup>e</sup> fork & from thence down the main branch until it meeth into y<sup>e</sup> Southly branch off Norton Creek after & So up the same to the Several Courses thereof to y<sup>e</sup> Place off Beginning -

This forty Eight acres off Meadow formerly Surveyed by Thomas Gaddins to Andrew Roberson Surveyor General by Richard Bull for Sixty Eight acres but by me Thomas Sharp found to run in upon st<sup>r</sup> Andrew Roberson former Survey y<sup>e</sup> now belongs to Richard Dickham So y<sup>e</sup> now it is but y<sup>e</sup> forty Eight as above. Beginning at a Post Standing by Followard River thence by the meadow off Richard Dickham South Easterly thirty three dgs Sixteen cha: to a Post thence North Easterly Sixty three dgs thirty one cha: to a Post thence by some Meadow belonging to Samuel Harrison North Westerly twenty eight dgs to a Post Standing by Followard River afore<sup>d</sup> & So down the same to the Place off Beginning
