CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO CHANGE THE LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING SCHEDULE IF CENSUS DATA IS DELAYED

DO YOU APPROVE AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION TO CHANGE WHEN NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS ARE CREATED IF THE FEDERAL CENSUS DATA IS DELAYED? THE CURRENT COVID-19 PANDEMIC HAS DELAYED CENSUS DATA COLLECTION. IF NEW JERSEY DOES NOT RECEIVE THE CENSUS DATA IN A TIMELY MANNER, NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS MAY NOT BE READY IN TIME FOR STATE LEGISLATIVE ELECTIONS IN THE YEAR ENDING IN ONE. THIS CHANGE TO THE REDISTRICTING SCHEDULE WILL ALLOW LEGISLATORS TO BE ELECTED THAT YEAR FROM THEIR EXISTING DISTRICTS FOR THEIR TWO-YEAR TERM IN OFFICE. THE NEW DISTRICTS WILL BE USED STARTING WITH THE NEXT SCHEDULED GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE STATE LEGISLATURE.

Interpretive Statement

THIS CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CHANGES WHEN NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS ARE CREATED IF THE FEDERAL CENSUS DATA IS DELAYED. THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION REQUIRES THAT A CENSUS BE TAKEN EVERY TEN YEARS TO COUNT THE PEOPLE LIVING IN THE COUNTRY. CENSUS DATA IS THEN USED TO CREATE NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS TO ENSURE RESIDENTS HAVE EQUAL REPRESENTATION FROM ELECTED OFFICIALS. HOWEVER, THE CURRENT COVID-19 PANDEMIC HAS DELAYED CENSUS DATA COLLECTION. THIS MAY DELAY CENSUS DATA TO THE STATES AND MAY AFFECT THE CREATION OF NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS. THE STATE CONSTITUTION REQUIRES AN APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION TO CREATE NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS EVERY TEN YEARS AFTER THE FEDERAL CENSUS IS COMPLETED. IF THE CENSUS DATA IS DELAYED, THE NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS MAY NOT BE CREATED IN A TIMELY MANNER TO HOLD ELECTIONS.
