N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDITS OF ELECTION RESULTS

2025 General Election

Audit Date: November 17, 2025

The Cumberland County Board of Elections (BOE herein) performed an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9 and the New Jersey Election Audit Procedures developed by the New Jersey State Division of Elections.

The Cumberland County BOE conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the General Election for all offices selected by the Secretary of State. The offices to be audited are that of the Governor, General Assembly, County Commissioners, and City Commissioners or Township Committee as directed by the Division of Elections and Secretary of State Tahesha Way. All other offices were excluded from the audit.

Pursuant to the statute, "Counties having less than 100 election districts shall audit at least two election districts."

There were 604 audit units for the County of Cumberland, 529 audit units in Legislative District 1 and 75 audit units in Legislative District 3. Eleven (11) election districts from Legislative District 1 and two (2) election districts from Legislative District 3 were selected for the audit. A total of thirteen (13) batches were audited.

The following audit units were randomly selected:

2. Mail-In Batch 290 Vineland City Ward 4 District 5 – Legislative District 1
3. Mail-In Batch 16 Commercial Township District 3 – Legislative District 1
4. Mail-In Batch 69 Vineland City Ward 5 District 1 – Legislative District 1
5. Mail-In Batch 203 Vineland City Ward 2 District 6 – Legislative District 1
6. Mail-In Batch 90 Bridgeton City Ward 1 District 1 – Legislative District 1
7. Mail-In Batch 10 Millville City Ward 3 District 1 – Legislative District 1
8. Mail-In Batch 61 Vineland City Ward 4 District 3 – Legislative District 1
9. Mail-In Batch 8 Millville City Ward 3 District 1 – Legislative District 1
10. Mail-In Batch 259 Vineland City Ward 4 District 7 – Legislative District 1
11. Mail-In Batch 98 Bridgeton City Ward 5 District 1 – Legislative District 1
12. Mail-In Batch 324 Deerfield Township District 1 – Legislative District 3
13. Provisional Batch 13 Stow Creek Township District 1 – Legislative District 3

In each district, the hand to eye audit was 100% consistent with the scanned tally. Any paper ballot which contained an overvote for a particular contest was recorded as an overvote but did not count as a vote.
