COMMENTS:

Old Bridge is divided by Congressional District 6 and Congressional District 12. Since each district in a polling location is added to a voting machine, the numbers of machines deployed cannot be broken down exactly by Congressional District. The number of Vote by Mail ballots counted by Congressional District does not match the municipality totals because of Overseas Civilians who can only vote a Federal ballot. Provisional ballots issued are still being tallied by the Board of Elections.
