COMMENTS:

Old Bridge is divided by Congressional District 6 and Congressional District 12. Since each district in a polling location is added to a voting machine, the numbers of machines deployed cannot be broken down exactly by Congressional District. The number of Vote by Mail ballots counted by Congressional District does not match the municipality totals because of Overseas Civilians who can only vote a Federal ballot. Provisional ballot totals by Congressional District are not final, as Old Bridge is split between districts. All Old Bridge provisional ballots are currently reflected under CD6 pending research and final district assignment.
