



New Jersey to Participate in ‘Bells of Peace’ on Armistice Centennial

In continuation of New Jersey’s efforts in 2017 - 2018 to mark the centennial of America’s involvement in World War I, the New Jersey Historical Commission is encouraging individuals, municipalities, and organizations across the state to toll bells twenty-one times on Sunday, November 11, 2018 at 11:00 am. Nationwide, bell-telling will honor the 116,515 American men and women who died in World War I and mark the centennial of the Armistice that brought an end to hostilities.
