1	Center Designation	The center boundary must be modified to exclude the beaches and dunes from the center. State agencies will work with the City to establish the center boundary.	4/1/2012
2	Coastal Consistency Statement	The City of Cape May shall develop and submit a Coastal Consistency Statement. Examples and information are available upon request.	4/1/2012
3	Wastewater Management Plan including water supply and stream corridor protection measures	The City must comply with the "Responsibility of Municipalities" obligations listed in section N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.8 of the Water Quality Management Rules. The Wastewater Management Plan must be up-to-date and consistent with the master plan and petition. Proposed wastewater service must be pulled back from areas not proposed for growth. Municipalities must provide documentation that water supply capacity exists for the amount of growth detailed in the Master Plan. This documentation must identify existing and proposed water supply sources. For existing public water sources, identify the available approved allocations and firm capacity. In addition, municipalities must identify local water conservation measures required to ensure efficient use of available resources and methods to be used to promote wastewater reuse. Stream corridor protection ordinances must be in place.	4/1/2012
4	Sustainability Statement	Update and enhance the Sustainability Statement narrative to include energy, mixed-use development, reducing GHGs, and Sustainable Jersey actions that the City plans or has already implemented to move the City towards a sustainable future.	4/1/2012
