Roadway Technician

The Division of Highway Operations is responsible for the maintenance and repair of New Jersey's roadway infrastructure system. The work is labor intensive and may include: litter and graffiti management; vegetation removal; mowing and trimming; pothole repair; plow & equipment repair and painting; minor equipment repairs; restroom/yard facility cleaning and hand sweeping.

Preferred Skills: Ability to work in a team setting; work in all weather conditions and at heights; work around certain fumes and chemical odors; and adhere to safety regulations.

Facilities Technician



Work Locations:

Lodi, Hamilton, Ewing and Deptford

The Division of Support Services is responsible for upkeep, maintenance and repairs to all NJDOT facilities and grounds statewide. The work is labor intensive and may include: landscape, grass cutting, weed whacking, leaf blowing and branch pickup; cleaning, sweeping, stripping, mopping and waxing floors and general surfaces; painting; HVAC filter changes and minor HVAC repairs; and minor plumbing and building repairs.

Preferred Skills: Ability to work in a team setting; work in all weather conditions and at heights; work around certain fumes and chemical odors; and adhere to safety regulations.

Work Authorization: Applicants must be authorized to work in the United States according to the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations. NJDOT does not provide sponsorship or accept student OPT/CPT programs, F1 or H1B work authorization visas.
