Note: Some of the questions have been paraphrased in the interest of readability and clarity. Each question is referenced by the appropriate solicitation page number(s) and section where applicable.

#	Question	Answer
1	Will truck accidents (ex: tractor and trailer) which usually require more man power and equipment, be handled under the normal NJ State Police rotation list?	A vendor may be asked to support the clearance of any incident but, the majority of major crashes will be handled by the NJSP rotational list.
2	Operators of tow trucks registered at 26,000lbs or less are not required to have a CDL. Will they be exempt from the CDL requirement?	If the class of vehicle requires a CDL, the driver must have a CDL.
3	Heavy Duty Wreckers and Flatbeds do not carry dollies. Will they be exempt from dolly requirements?	Yes
4	Will you consider consulting with towing industry leaders prior to putting out future bids for towing?	This Waiver is being advertised for the 2020/21 Winter Season. It is anticipated that a new multi-year term contract will be advertised in the upcoming months by the State of New Jersey, Division of Purchase & Property. NJDOT does not foresee putting out any future bids for towing.
