A bicycle/pedestrian path will be constructed along the Delaware River from Stacy Park to Assunpink Creek.

The federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) provided funding for this project under Section 1601, High Priority Projects Program. The Act allocated \$4.13 M for the Route 29 bicycle, pedestrian, and landscape improvements in Trenton. FY 2000 and FY2001 RABAs have increased the total authorization amount to \$4,233,630. The FY 2004 federal Transportation and Community System Preservation Program provided \$1,000,000 for the Route 29 Bike/Pedestrian project.

This project is located along Main Street (Route 29) which experiences flooding conditions several times a year due to a lack of adequate drainage system along Main Street. The flooding affects traffic as well as the adjacent school. The roadway is in poor condition and requires reconstruction. The project will include reconstruction of Route 29, drainage improvements (new drainage pipe as well as new inlets), and aesthetic treatments recommended as part of the Scenic Byway Project (sidewalks, curbs, crosswalks, planting of trees, ADA ramps, and guiderail).
