Route 40 will be reconstructed to provide a new riding surface within the project limits. The shoulders and two feet of the travel lanes will be reconstructed with new pavement. The drainage system will be upgraded by adding new drainage ditches, new pipes and new inlets where required.

In the downtown area of Elmer, new curbing and sidewalk will be provided where required. The intersection of Front Street and Route 40 will be improved by providing a new curve with a better radius and superelevation rate. Also, a new traffic island, striping and signing will be provided at this intersection. The bridge over Elmer Lake will be replaced with a new bridge structure. The new bridge will have 12-foot travel lanes, eight-foot shoulders and six-foot sidewalks in both directions.

This project is funded under the provisions of Section 13 of P.L. 1995, c.108. Total construction cost is anticipated to be \$9,835,000.
