This program will benefit Smart Growth in the corridor.

The existing deteriorated bridge over Merrill's Creek will be replaced along with upgrades to the Route 57 roadway approaches. The new structure and roadway will consist of two 12-foot travel lanes and two 8-foot shoulders. All sub-standard features will be upgraded. The project does not include significant widening of the existing roadway section, nor does it add any new travel lanes. The project will be bicycle compatible.
