ARC is proposing an expansion of passenger rail capacity serving Midtown Manhattan to accommodate service for additional lines and provide capacity for growth on existing services. ARC includes construction of a connection between the Main Line & NEC, added tracks along the Northeast Corridor Line, a new trans-Hudson River tunnel, and additional station capacity at or near Penn Station, New York. Other infrastructure changes include E-Yard Expansion, West End Concourse Extension, and Eastward Extension of PSNY Platforms 1 and 2. These improvements will allow accommodation of future travel demand and relieve congestion on alternative modes of travel. Also provided are \$181,273 carryover FY04 Section 115 funds, \$5.815M carryover FY05 Section 5307 funds and \$920,153M of carryover FY05 Section 5309 funds.
