Washington Township has experienced significant population growth and Egg Harbor Road provides the direct link from the Rt. 55 interchange on Rt. 47 near Five Points to the heart of Washington Township at the junction of Hurffville-Cross Keys Road. The roadway narrows down from a four-lane roadway to two with auxiliary lanes in this stretch of roadway.

This project is multi-year funded under the provisions of Section 13 of P.L. 1995, c.108. Total construction funding needed is expected to be \$13,000,000.

The study showed the preferred concept to service the site would be a roadway from the eastern or southern boundary, bridging Mantua Creek and connecting to the newly improved Interchange 19 on I-295 via Paradise Road (CR 656).
