The existing structure was built in 1972 as a temporary single-span structure. The bridge consists of simply supported steel acrow panel trusses and is supported on concrete abutments. The bridge has inadequate deck geometry and substandard lane widths. The existing metal bridge deck components are overstressed (under-designed). This bridge is considered structurally deficient and functionally obsolete and hence is in need of replacement. The new structure will provide two 3.65 meter lanes, adequate shoulders on both sides, one sidewalk and will be constructed on an improved alignment.

The existing single-span acrow panel truss bridge was built in 1983 as a temporary structure. The bridge is classified as functionally obsolete, due to inadequate deck geometry. The "Bridge Re-Evaluation Survey Report" has recommended that this structure be replaced. The deck pans, floor beams, deck ribs and trusses suffer from moderate to severe rust. The sufficiency rating for this bridge is 2.0. The county proposes to replace this bridge with an improved permanent structure.

The existing acrow panel truss bridge is an 80-foot span that was built in 1977 as a temporary structure, has inadequate deck geometry, is structurally deficient and has no sidewalks. The bridge suffers from damaged bottom chords, moderate to severe corrosion of the lower chord channels and ends of the floor beams, heavily rusted weld connections. In addition, both bridge approaches have poor horizontal alignment. The structure is classified as functionally obsolete and has been recommended for replacement since 1990, due to the temporary nature of the structure and its condition. The county proposes to replace this bridge with an improved permanent structure.

The subject structure, built in 1927, is rated as critical. The structure will be replaced with a new structure on approximately the same alignment as the existing structure. The project will include construction of two 3.6 meter traffic lanes, two 3.0 meter shoulders, roadway curbing and a west sidewalk along the southern approach to the Franklin Road intersection. To the north, the shoulders and sidewalk must terminate at the Blackwell Street intersection. This project will be bicycle/pedestrian compatible.

**Operational improvements at Powder Mill Road**

This project will provide for operational improvements at Powder Mill Road. A new loop ramp will be constructed in the northwest quadrant of the intersection to accommodate Route 10 westbound traffic destined to Powder Mill Road southbound or Route 10 eastbound (U-turn). The existing forward jughandle from Route 10 westbound will be reconfigured to permit right turns only (access to Powder Mill Road northbound). Route 10 will be widened at the intersection to accommodate an exclusive turn lane for the existing ramp and the new ramp. Construction of a 10-foot shoulder adjacent to the eastbound lanes will provide additional safety. The rock outcrop along Route 10 eastbound immediately west of the intersection will be stabilized. Powder Mill Road north of Route 10 will be widened to accommodate a longer left-turn lane. This project will be bicycle/pedestrian compatible.

This project will improve the Route 206/CR 24/513 intersection by adding a left-turn lane in each direction on Route 206. There are no plans to widen CR 24/513. Unless provided by others, the project will also include the addition of a traffic signal and left-turn lanes in each direction in the vicinity of MP 86.85 (shopping center entrance). Provisions will also be made for an unsignalized southbound left-turn lane into Colby Farm Road in Chester Township at approximately MP 86.55. Route 206 will have 15-foot outside lanes which are bicycle compatible. The intersection of Route 206/CR 24/513 will include improved pedestrian crossings. The project will also include sidewalks along Route 206 (replacement of existing sidewalks as well as supplemental sidewalks).
