Passaic Street is a two-lane roadway that crosses Route 17 in Rochelle Park. It is the municipality's major commercial street, connects with heavily congested Route 17, and provides access to the Garden State Plaza Mall. As a result, Passaic Street experiences high traffic volumes and a deteriorating level of service. Westbound traffic is negatively impacted by left-turn movements to and from the Route 17 ramps. During peak periods, the queues from vehicles turning left onto the Route 17 south ramp extend for over 500 feet and impact the Passaic Street/Rochelle Avenue intersection. The project includes improvements on portions of Passaic Street, Pleasant Avenue and Farview Avenue, as well as main line Route 17.
