This project proposes consolidation of interstate ramps at a single location at the east end of Harrison to serve access needs to the southeastern part of town and alleviate traffic bottlenecks. The feasibility assessment is being handled as a local lead project.

The following special Federal appropriations were allocated to this project: 1) SAFETEA-LU FY 2005: Transportation Improvements \$3,000,000 (ID# NJ 265); 2) High Priority Funding \$2,000,000 and \$8,000,000 (ID# NJ 249); these amounts are available over a five-year period. 3) FY 2005/Interstate Maintenance \$1,000,000 (ID# NJA 239); 4) FY 2005/National Corridor Planning and Border Development program \$992,000 (ID# NJA 49); 5) FY06 SAFETEA-LU \$3,000,000 and \$8,000,000 (ID# NJ 210),(available 20% per year).
