This widening will then allow the existing lane to be used as a third thru lane on Rt. 18 NB which will eliminate a merge conflict between Rt. 18 NB traffic and NJ Turnpike traffic eliminating backups on Rt. 18 NB and the NJ Turnpike. The project will also modify Ramp D from Rt. 18 NB to Rt. 1 SB and replacement of the entire Rt. 18 NB/SB super structure utilizing precast superstructure units.
