As part of our commitment to developing transportation improvements that best balance transportation needs, the environment, community concerns, and cost, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) will hold a Public Information Center (PIC) to provide local residents and businesses with information on the Route 46, Pequannock Street to CR 513 (West Main Street) project. You are encouraged to actively participate by providing comments at the meeting, by mail, or by e-mail.

THE MEETING

The PIC will be held on Thursday, June 20, 2019 at the Rockaway Township Municipal Building, 65 Mount Hope Rd., Rockaway Twp. NJ 07866, from 6-8 p.m. You will have an opportunity to review exhibits of the project, ask questions, and discuss any concerns with NJDOT staff members. BACKGROUND

The overall purpose of this project is to improve safety along Route 46 between Pequannock Street and CR 513, West Main Street (MP 38.26-39.85), while minimizing impacts to the surrounding environment, access, right of way and utilities. The current calculated safety score for this project segment is 10 on a scale of 0 to 10 with 0 representing no crashes in the area and 10 representing the worst score.

THE PROJECT

The project will provide intersection and pedestrian safety improvements along the corridor, such as:

1. Signal upgrades/replacements at each of the signalized intersections, including 12 LED signal

- heads, countdown pedestrian signal heads, lighting, timing optimization, etc.
- 2. ADA compliant curb ramps and sidewalk repairs
- 3. Convert Route 46 and E. McFarlan/Depew/ King/Nelson into a 4-leg intersection by converting King Street to one-way away from Route 46 and providing curb extensions on the Depew Avenue and King Street legs
- 4. Sidewalk connection from Lee Avenue to Mt Prospect Avenue (crossing at the shopping
- 5. Sidewalk connection from Swede Mine Rd to CR 513 (crossing at Route 46/CVS)
- 6. Potential one-way operation or turn restrictions at certain unsignalized intersections
- 7. Address drainage issues at Mt Hope/Route 15, Welsh Lane and George Street
- 8. Updating signage to direct bicyclists to use an alternate, parallel route
