The Department shall reserve the right to demand from the applicant, as a condition of any permit, a certified check in an amount sufficient to guarantee or insure proper maintenance or restoration of the area disturbed. If it becomes necessary that the Department forces, for any reason, are required to make repairs, the cost of such work shall be deducted from the principal and the remainder, if any, shall be returned after the project has been completed and accepted. If the amount of the guarantee is less that the cost of the additional work, the applicant shall be billed for the balance due.

If a permit is granted, I or we, agree to comply with the rules and regulations of the New Jersey Department of Transportation as set forth in the conditions included therein and on page 2 of this form. In addition, I or we, understand the N.J.S.A. 27:7-44.1 makes any violation of the provisions of the permit subject to a fine (Note exceeding \$100.00 per day) and civil action for the costs of prosecution as well as civil action for trespass to remove any non-conforming use. No work in connection with this application will be started until the final permit is approved and issued.

CONDITIONS

Location of Bridge Attachment, installation, design, details, and plan requirements shall be in accordance with the provisions of section 34A of the Department of Transportation Design Manual for Bridges and Structures.

NOTICE PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION

The permittee shall notify the Region Office of the Construction and Maintenance Unit at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to starting work in order that the Department may have a representative at the site.

PROTECTION OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The permittee shall properly safeguard all work performed under permit and if considered necessary, maintain sufficient warning lights, Departmental approved signs and safety devices for the protection of the general public at all times, until the project has been completed.

PROTECTION FROM SUITS

The permittee shall defend, indemnify, protect and save harmless the State and its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of, any negligent act, error, or omission of the permittee, its agents, servants, and employees in the performance of the work covered by this permit.

PROTECTION OF STRUCTURES

The proposed installation shall in no way obstruct or interfere with the water way or with the free and clear use of the space under the viaduct or bridge.

MATERIAL, CONSTRUCTION, AND MAINTENANCE

Materials and workmanship used in construction affecting highway property shall be in accordance with the New Jersey Department of Transportation standard specifications for road and bridge construction (Including supplements) dated 1983.

The construction and maintenance of the proposed installation shall be at the sole expense of the applicant and at no cost to the State. If the maintenance of the installation unduly interferes with the maintenance of a part of the State's structure, applicant will maintain such portion of the State's structure. Whenever it becomes necessary for the state to make repairs to its structure, applicant will upon notice from the State, protect and/or relocate if necessary its installation during the time the repairs are being made by the State.

INSPECTION

All materials, construction and maintenance in connection with the installation shall be subject to inspection and approval of the Department.

TERMINATION OF PERMIT

Permits will not be issued for a period in excess of 12 months. If extension time is needed for the completion of the work, approval may be obtained by letter of request and accompanied by an extension fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00); and if the Department deems it necessary a new application must be filed. The permit issued in pursuance of these rules and regulations shall apply only to the viaduct or bridge therein referred to. In the event that the viaduct or bridge therein referred to shall be subsequently destroyed, demolished, relocated, or abandoned, the rights granted by such permit shall cease and terminate.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

This permit is subject to all municipal ordinances, rules and regulation. The Department of Transportation may impose special conditions in special cases.
