Subpart 159.03.02 of the 2007 Standard Specifications for the Road and Bridge Construction has been revised to ensure that unacceptable barrier curb is not delivered to the project.

The changes to the Standard Input, SI2007 is as follows:

## 159.03.02 Traffic Control Devices

2. Construction Barrier Curb.

THE SECOND PARAGRAPH AS IT APPEARS IN THE SLIS CHANGED TO:

At least 30 days before delivering construction barrier curb to the Project Limits, provide the RE notice that the barrier curb is available for inspection. The RE will inspect the barrier curb, along with a Contractor representative, to determine what pieces are not approved for delivery to the Project Limits. Final determination of construction barrier approval will be made at the time of placement at the Project.

Changes must be implemented in all applicable Department projects scheduled for Final Design Submission at least one month after the date of the BDC announcement. This will allow designers to make necessary plan, specifications, and estimate/proposal changes without requiring the need for an addenda or postponement of advertisement or receipt of bids.
