The most recent modifications to the NJTR-I went into effect on January 1, 2023. The previous NJTR-I report form collected data in 149 blocks; the new reports include an additional four blocks for a total of 153 blocks. Also, as listed below, additional choices have been added, modified, or removed for specific blocks.

Details about these changes and additional guidance on other NJTR-1 fields can be found in the latest version of the New Jersey NJTR-1 Report Manual, Edition 2.0, and appear in green text. Prior versions of the manual should be discarded.

Block 86 (Victim's Physical Condition)

- Do not leave this block blank and do not enter a dash.
- Enter the code 01 through 05 to identify the level of severity of an injury.

Block 92 and 93 (Safety Equipment)

- 06 Not Deployed has been added

Block 108 109 (Vehicle Type)

Block 112/113 (Special Function Vehicles)

Block 120a/b and 121a/b (Apparent Physical Status)
