Route 440 southbound U-turn at Amboy Avenue to close tonight for priority repairs in Perth Amboy, Middlesex County Signed detour will be in place using Amboy Avenue

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the closure and detour of the Route 440 southbound U-turn at Amboy Avenue in Perth Amboy for priority repairs.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, July 20, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 440 southbound U-turn at Amboy Avenue in Perth Amboy, Middlesex County for priority repairs. The exit ramp to North 440/North 35/Amboy Avenue will remain open. The following signed detour will remain in place until further notice:

Route 440 southbound U-turn at Amboy Avenue Detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the Route 440 southbound U-turn at Amboy Avenue will be directed to keep right on the exit ramp and continue towards Amboy Avenue
- Turn left at the traffic signal onto Amboy Avenue
- Turn left onto the ramp back to Route 440 northbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
