Route 4/Route 17 overnight ramp closures required tonight for light pole installation in Paramus, Bergen County Three ramps will be closed and detoured in stages overnight

(Trenton) –New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight ramp closures at the Route 4/Route 17 interchange for light pole installation in Paramus, Bergen County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 7, NJDOT's Contractor, Orchard Holdings, is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 17 southbound to Route 4 eastbound. This closure will allow the contractor to install high mast light polls. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 17 southbound ramp to Route 4 eastbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 17 southbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 4 eastbound will be directed to keep right on the ramp to Route 4 westbound
- Take the ramp towards Garden State Plaza/U-turn and keep right (follow U-turn signs)
- Merge onto Ikea Drive and cross over Route 4
- Turn left at the traffic signal onto the ramp to Route 4 eastbound
- Keep left and merge onto Route 4 eastbound

At approximately 12 midnight, the Route 17 southbound ramp to Route 4 eastbound will reopen and the ramp from Route 4 eastbound to Route 17 southbound will be closed. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 4 eastbound to Route 17 southbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 4 eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 17 southbound will be directed to continue on Route 4 eastbound
- Take the ramp to Spring Valley Road
- Turn left at the end of the ramp to take the overpass over Route 4
- Use the left lane to turn left onto Spring Valley Road
- Take the ramp to Route 4 westbound
- Take the ramp to Route 17 southbound

At 3 a.m., Saturday, May 8, the ramp from Route 4 eastbound to Route 17 southbound will reopen and the ramp from Route 4 eastbound to Route 17 northbound will be closed. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 4 eastbound ramp to Route 17 northbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 4 eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 17 northbound will be directed to continue on Route 4 eastbound
- Take the ramp to Spring Valley Road

- Turn left at the end of the ramp to take the overpass over Route 4
- Use the left lane to turn left onto Spring Valley Road
- Take the ramp to Route 4 westbound
- Take the ramp to Route 17 northbound

By 6 a.m. Saturday, May 8, the light pole installation will be complete and the Route 4 eastbound ramp to Route 17 northbound will reopen.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
