Route 1&9 southbound ramps to and from Paterson Plank Road closed and detoured tonight in North Bergen Overnight closure necessary for milling and paving

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the Route 1&9 southbound ramps to and from Paterson Plank Road will be closed and detoured tonight and tomorrow night for milling and paving in North Bergen.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Thursday, August 5 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, August 6, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is scheduled to close and detour the Route 1&9 southbound ramps to and from Paterson Plank Road for milling and paving. The following detours will be in place:

Route 1&9 southbound to Paterson Plank Road Detour

- Traffic on Route 1&9 southbound wishing to use the ramp to Paterson Plank Road will be directed to continue on Route 1&9 southbound
- Continue under Route 495 and past the intersection with Route 3
- Take the jughandle across from Wendy's and make a U-turn
- Take Route 1&9 northbound
- Take the ramp to Paterson Plank Road under Route 495, just north of Route 3.

Paterson Plank Road to Route 1&9 southbound Detour

- Traffic on Paterson Plank Road wishing to use the ramp to Route 1&9 southbound will be directed to continue on Paterson Plank Road westbound
- Cross over Route 3 and take the ramp to Route 3 eastbound
- Stay to the left on Route 3 eastbound local continuing under Route 495
- At the traffic signal turn right onto Route 1&9 southbound

Variable Message Signs will be used to provide advance notification to motorists. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
