Route 206 southbound to be closed this weekend for repairs to New Jersey Turnpike ramp in Bordentown New Jersey Turnpike ramp to Route 206 southbound to remain closed

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 206 southbound will be closed this weekend as part of a New Jersey Turnpike bridge repair project in Bordentown, Burlington County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, April 29 until 5 a.m. Monday, May 2, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's contractor, Ferreira Construction Company, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour Route 206 southbound before the ramp to the New Jersey Turnpike to allow for the demolition of a portion of the bridge over Route 206. Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses between Route 130 to just past Dunn's Mill Road. The following detours will be in place this weekend:

Route 206 southbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 206 Southbound will be directed to take Route 130 southbound
- Take the ramp to I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 52A/Columbus
- Take Columbus Road/CR 542 east
- Turn left to take the ramp to Route 206 southbound

Route 206 southbound to New Jersey Turnpike detour:

- Motorists on Route 206 Southbound wishing to go to the New Jersey Turnpike will be directed to take Route 130 southbound
- Take the ramp to the New Jersey Turnpike/I-95
- Stay left for the New Jersey Turnpike

New Jersey Turnpike Exit 7 to Route 206 northbound and southbound detour:

(The ramp from the New Jersey Turnpike to Route 206 southbound will be reopen after this closure. Ramp from Route 206 Southbound to Interchange 7 will remain closed until further notice.)

- All traffic wishing to exit the New Jersey Turnpike at Interchange 7 will be directed to continue on the New Jersey Turnpike to Interchange 6
- Take the Interchange 6 ramp to Route 130 northbound
- Take the ramp to I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 52A/Columbus
- Take the ramp to I-295 northbound
- Take I-295 northbound to Exit 56/Rising Sun Road
- Turn right on Rising Sun Road
- Turn left onto the Connector Road back to Route 206

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
