I-80 westbound on-ramp from Landing Road northbound to be closed tonight for bridge work in Roxbury Closures required for deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the I-80 westbound on-ramp from Landing Road northbound will be closed overnight tonight for bridge work in Roxbury, Morris County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, June 3, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, June 4, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction, is scheduled to close and detour the ramp from Landing Road northbound to I-80 westbound. The closure is necessary to make concrete repairs to the bridge deck over Landing Road. The following detour will be in place:

Landing Road northbound to I-80 westbound ramp detour:

- Motorists on Route 46 westbound wishing to take the ramp from Landing Road northbound to I-80 westbound will be directed to continue on Route 46 westbound
- Turn left onto Ledgewood Avenue, Route 183 southbound
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound/Route 206 northbound

The work is part of a \$21.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
