Route 20 northbound left turn lane to Edward Street to close Monday as roadway rehabilitation project advances in Passaic County Closure and detour to remain in place for approximately two weeks

(Trenton) – The left turn lane from Route 20 northbound onto Edward Street is scheduled to be closed and detoured on Monday as the Route 20 Paterson Safety, Drainage, and Resurfacing project advances in Paterson, Passaic County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. Monday, June 12, the left turn lane from Route 20 northbound onto Edward Street is scheduled to be closed and detoured. The closure is necessary to set up a work zone under the Route 4/Broadway overpass for work scheduled to begin on the bridge next week. Motorists wishing to turn left onto Edward Street will be directed to continue on Route 20 northbound and follow the posted detour. This traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately two weeks.

The \$48.5 million federally funded Route 20 Paterson Safety, Drainage, and Resurfacing project will make upgrades and repairs along approximately five miles of Route 20 in Clifton and Paterson, Passaic County. In addition to drainage improvements, the project will include repaving, guiderail replacement, lighting and overhead sign installation, and upgrades to traffic signals, curbs and sidewalks. The project is expected to be completed by the fall of 2025.
