Route 208 southbound lane closures tonight as culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County **Closure necessary to implement traffic shift**

(Trenton) – Route 208 southbound is scheduled to have lane closures tonight as a culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 22, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 23, lane closures are scheduled on a portion of Route 208 southbound between Cedar Hill Avenue and Russell Avenue to restripe the road to implement a traffic shift. At least one lane will be maintained on Route 208 southbound overnight. By 6 a.m. Saturday, two lanes will be open with traffic shifted to the left. This traffic pattern is expected to remain in place for a few weeks for concrete pipe installation in the culvert, as well as paving, fence, guiderail work.

The \$3.9 million federally funded project will replace the existing culverts on Route 208 northbound and southbound between mile posts 6.2 and 6.4. The project also includes guiderail replacement. Work is expected to be complete in summer 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
