Route 17 northbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County Closure necessary for bridge repairs

(Trenton) – Route 17 northbound is scheduled to be closed tonight at Williams Avenue in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, October 13 until 3 p.m. Saturday, October 14, Route 17 northbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured at Williams Avenue to repair the netting underneath the Route 46 overpass. The following detour will be in place:

Route 17 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 17 northbound will be directed to stay left to take the ramp to Route 46 eastbound/Palisades Park
- Stay right to take the first exit ramp to Green Street/Hackensack
- Turn right onto Green Street
- Turn right to take the ramp to Route 46 westbound
- Stay right to take the first exit ramp to Route 17 northbound/Paramus

The work is part of a \$22.6 million state-funded maintenance contract to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
