Route 202 closed in both directions for emergency drainage pipe repair in Harding, Morris County At least one lane will be maintained overnight

(Trenton) – Route 202 is closed and detoured in both directions for emergency drainage repairs in Harding, Morris County.

At approximately 11 a.m. today, Friday, April 19, Route 202 was closed in both directions between Glen Alpin Road/Tempe Wick Road/CR 646 and Sand Spring Road in Harding for emergency drainage pipe replacement near Camp Road. Local access will be maintained for residents. The following detours are expected to be in place through Saturday afternoon:

Route 202 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 202 northbound will be directed to turn right onto Glen Alpin Road/CR 646.
- Turn left onto Blue Mill Road
- Turn left onto Sand Spring Road back to Route 202

Route 202 southbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 202 southbound will be directed to turn left onto Sand Spring Road
- Turn right onto Blue Mill Road
- Turn right onto Glen Alpin Road/CR 646 back to Route 202

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
