High School Equivalency Program (HEP)

Funding Agency: Department of Health and Human Services

Purpose: To assist migratory or seasonal farmworkers (or immediate family members of such workers) to obtain the equivalent of a secondary school diploma and subsequently to gain improved employment, enter military service, or be placed in an institution of higher education (IHE) or other postsecondary education or training.

Eligibility: Private, public, and state institutions of higher education, nonprofits that do and do not have a 501(c)(3), others.

Funding: \$6,650,000; awards up to \$475,000

College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP)

Funding Agency: Department of Health and Human Services

Purpose: To assist migratory or seasonal farmworkers (or immediate family members of such workers) who are enrolled or are admitted for enrollment on a full-time basis at an institution of higher education (IHE) to complete their first academic year.

Eligibility: Private, public, and state institutions of higher education, nonprofits that do and do not have a 501(c)(3), others.

Funding: \$5,225,000; awards up to \$475,000

Eligibility: State, city, township, special district, Native American, and county governments, public/Indian housing authorities, unrestricted, private, public, and state institutions of higher education, nonprofits that do and do not have 501(c)(3), Native American tribal organizations, small businesses, independent school districts, for profits organizations, others.

Funding: \$1,800,000; awards up to \$150,000

Humanities Research Centers on Artificial Intelligence

Funding Agency: National Endowment for the Humanities

Purpose: To support the establishment of new collaborative humanities research centers focused on the legal, ethical, or societal implications of developing AI technologies.

Eligibility: County, city, state, special district, township, and Native American governments, nonprofits having a 501(c)(3), private institutions of higher education.

Funding: \$2,500,000; awards up to \$500,000

Digital Humanities Advancement Grants

Funding Agency: National Endowment for the Humanities

Purpose: To support work that is innovative, experimental, and contributes to the critical infrastructure that underpins scholarly research, teaching, and public programming in the humanities.

Eligibility: County, city, state, special district, township, and Native American governments, nonprofits having a 501(c)(3), public, state, and private institutions of higher education.

Funding: \$2,200,000; awards up to \$35,000
