Reports

M-1 New Business Trustee Megariotis provided an update regarding the services the Division of Pensions and Benefits provides to the membership. He informed the Board that 32 new phone counselors have been hired; 24 having completed training and 8 will complete the training program in the next few weeks. The Call Center hours have been expanded with three shifts running from 7:00a.m. until 6:00p.m. A program has been instituted for call back assistance, which is averaging up to 600 call backs per week. In addition, the Division is considering a pilot program with a chat feature with a live person to be rolled out in the future. The Division continues to address a number of challenges which include dropped calls, monitoring incoming calls, and the issue that the video counseling program will not allow enrollment for online seminars until a year out, which is not accurate. Online seminars are available to be scheduled at this time for the last two weeks in January 2022.

Trustee Colacci requested a report from Director Petzold indicating the number of retirees/beneficiaries and the amounts of benefits being paid from the PFRS.
