## POST THIS PERS STATE MEMBER NOTICE IN A PUBLIC AREA AT THE WORKPLACE

- The Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) during its meeting on January 18, 2017, deemed William O'Brien elected to a three-year term as State Representative to the PERS Board, effective July 1, 2017.
- Mr. O'Brien was the only candidate to obtain 500 or more eligible PERS State member nominations on-line or by paper petition. Therefore, in accordance with <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 17:2-1.4, the PERS Board noted that Mr. O'Brien is elected to the State Representative position without balloting.
- Mr. O'Brien is employed by William Paterson University of New Jersey in a PERS-covered position. Mr. O'Brien has served as a State Representative on the PERS Board since July 1, 2011.
