The length of an employee's Interchange is limited by N.J.A.C. 4A:6-4.8(c). The employee cannot be assigned for more than 12 months or less than two months in a 36-month period.

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Civil Service Commission may approve an assignment of less than two months in emergency situations. The CEO may also extend an interchange assignment for up to six additional months to complete work in progress; the maximum total assignment cannot exceed 18 months in a 36-month period. Official documentation of such an extension must be filed with the New Jersey Division of Pensions & Benefits (NJDPB).
