A new, enhanced version of NJSTART (Version 14.5) will be released on April 2, 2018 and will feature a redesigned user interface, faster search, and advanced reporting capabilities.

Version 14.5 provides a more engaging and productive experience to end-users to deliver even greater efficiency and transparency. It processes search requests and transactions faster and includes some key functionality improvements that make the procurement portal more like an everyday shopping experience.

NJSTART is a procure-to-pay solution that provides complete support for all procurement-related processes and system requirements, including: sourcing, receiving, vendor registration and management, solicitation, quotes, accounts payable, government-to-business punch-outs, and requisitioning.

Version 14.5 features many software enhancements and additional platform capabilities, including:

- Redesigned User Interface – Major portions have been redesigned from the ground up.
- Faster Search – New cutting-edge search technology helps users get more accurate results, faster.
- Improved Reporting and Dashboards – The business intelligence module has additional advanced filtering capabilities.
