Part II — Residency Information

1. Enter the date you first occupied the principal residence (main home) for which you are claiming the 2023 Senior Freeze.

2. Enter address of your previous main home. This is the home where you last applied for and were eligible for a Senior Freeze before you moved.

Part III — Documentation

Proof of Change of Main Home Must be Submitted With Form PTR-1C.

You must enclose copies of the following with your application:

- 1. Deed to the main home for which you are applying for the 2023 Senior Freeze. If a mobile home owner, contract(s) or agreement(s) from the mobile home park showing the amount of your site fees; and
2. Proof of date you first occupied the home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze. Examples of acceptable documentation include copies of New Jersey driver's license or motor vehicle registration, verification of voter registration, and copies of tax returns listing your address of record.

(If you complete this form, enclose it with your Form PTR-1 application.)

Form PTR-1C – Instructions

Part I – Identification

Social Security Number. If your marital/civil union status on December 31, 2023, was single, enter only your Social Security number in the space provided on Form PTR-1C. If your status on December 31, 2023, was married/CU couple, you must report both applicants' numbers in the order in which the names are listed on the application. If you were married or in a civil union but living apart from your spouse/civil union partner, and you did not have access to or receive support from their income, you are considered "Single" for purposes of the Senior Freeze. You should enter only your Social Security number on Form PTR-1C.

Name and Address. Print or type your name (last name first) and complete address of the property for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze in the spaces provided. Also include your spouse's/civil union partner's name if filing jointly.

Block/Lot/Qualifier. If you are a homeowner, enter the block and lot numbers of the main home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze in the spaces provided. Include qualifier if applicable. (Only condominiums may have qualifiers assigned to them.)

Mobile Home Park Site Number. If you are a mobile home owner, enter the mobile home park site number of the main home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze in the space provided.

Part II – Residency Information

Line 1. Enter in the spaces provided the month, day, and year you first occupied the main home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze.

Line 2. Enter in the space provided the complete address of your previous main home. This is the place that was your main home before you moved to the home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze. You must have applied for and been eligible for a Senior Freeze for property taxes (or mobile home park site fees) paid for the last full year you occupied your previous main home. If you moved between January 1, 2020, and December 31, 2020, you must have applied for and been eligible for a Senior Freeze for 2019 for your previous home. If you moved between January 1, 2021, and December 31, 2021, you must have applied for and been eligible for a Senior Freeze for 2020 for your previous home.

Line 3. Enter in the spaces provided the month, day, and year you moved from the main home indicated at line 2.

Part III – Documentation

You must enclose proof of when you moved to the home for which you are claiming the Senior Freeze and established that it was your main home. Be sure to enclose copies of the required documents. Do not send originals.

General Information

Residency Requirements. If you complete this verification form (PTR-1C) and enclose it with your Senior Freeze (Property Tax Reimbursement) Application (Form PTR-1), **do not fill in the oval for either "Yes" or "No" at line 5 on Form PTR-1.** The information you provide on Form PTR-1C will determine whether you have occupied your current main home long enough to meet the residency requirement for applicants who applied for and were eligible for reimbursements prior to moving to a new home.
