**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL FACILITIES SUBJECT TO THE
AIR TOXICS SURCHARGE**

Please be advised that pending legislation, if enacted, will retroactively repeal the Air Toxics Surcharge (P.L. 2004, c. 51). Assembly Bill 3667, which provides for repeal, was passed by the New Jersey Assembly on March 14, 2005 (77-0-0) and was referred to the Senate for action.

The DUE DATE for the Air Toxics Surcharge Return Assessment (Form ATX-100) with payment relating to emissions reported on the RPPR for the 2002 calendar year HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO JULY 15, 2005, pending any legislative action by the Senate.

The Division of Taxation will send another mailing describing the refund procedure for those facilities that have already remitted payment if the repeal legislation is enacted.
